**1. E-OPD tele-consultation services at AIIMS, Bhopal**

AIIMS, Bhopal has been extending the Out Patient (OPD) consultation services through 'eOPD' facility to the patients since June 2020. At present, 24 Specialty and Superspecialty departments are providing eOPD services through tele-consultation and video-conferencing on eHospital portal (available at link: **ORS.gov.in**) hosted by the National Informatics Centre (NIC) as a joint initiative of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW) and Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology.

Till date, 259 patients have been provided consultation through this portal, and the numbers seeking consultation are rising as patients learn about the facility. The doctors of all the departments providing eOPD services have been provided training, resource materials, and are continually supported by the IT team of AIIMS, Bhopal. Video tutorial and Patient guide in Hindi has also been made available for helping and guiding patients for booking and availing eOPD services. The Online Registration System (ORS) has a simple registration process and user-friendly interface for booking appointments with doctors at hospitals on the e-portal.

This been done at AIIMS, Bhopal in an effort to reach out to the community and patients for providing medical consultation when routine care and OPD at most facilities is affected due to the COVID-19 pandemic. It allows for people to take medical opinion without having to travel long distances, or visit hospital thereby reducing the risk of exposure to infection. A

preliminary assessment and advice by the doctor is possible based on information provided by the patient during the teleconsultation session over a mobile or as videoconference. It is possible for the patient to upload earlier medical records and reports prior to the appointment.

AIIMS, Bhopal remains committed to providing health services to the region, and is reaching out to people for health needs when people cannot reach the hospital like earlier times.

Prof.Sarman Singh, Director, AIIMS Bhopal has expressed that the information regarding these services should be disseminated far and wide so that maximum number of people can benefit from it.

## **2. Status report of Covid-19 patients at 08:00 AM (14<sup>th</sup> August)**

### **A. Patient Census:** Cumulative admissions of Covid-19 patients till date in AIIMS Bhopal –Nine Hundred Fifty One (951)

Total One Hundred Forty (140) Covid-19 patients are presently admitted in AIIMS, Bhopal.

There were Eleven (11) new admissions of Covid-19 patients in AIIMS, Bhopal in last 24 hours.

One Hundred One (101) Covid-19 positive patients are receiving treatment at Covid-19 wards, AIIMS Bhopal. They are clinically stable.

Twenty One (21) critically ill patients are admitted in Covid-19 ICU and are on oxygen support.

All admitted patients are receiving treatment as per Covid-19 treatment protocol.

### **B. Discharges Status:** Till date a total of Five Hundred Fifty Eight (558) Covid-19 patients got recovered after successful treatment and care from AIIMS Bhopal. One Hundred Eighty Two (182) patients in total were permitted for home isolation till this date.

Seventeen (17) Covid-19 patients got discharged after successful treatment and care on 13<sup>th</sup> August from AIIMS Bhopal.

Eleven (011) Covid-19 patients were permitted for home isolation in accordance to protocol and guidelines.

These Patients and their family expressed gratitude towards the doctors and staff of AIIMS Bhopal for rendering good care and services.

- C. Death Status:** Since beginning of Covid-19 crisis a total of Sixty Four (64) deaths could be attributed to Covid-19 including Two (02) brought dead in AIIMS Bhopal. This includes the death of a eighty three year old male Covid-19 patient from Sehore who has breathed his last in Covid-19 ICU on 14<sup>th</sup> August. He was admitted since 04<sup>th</sup> August in AIIMS Bhopal and having Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD) as co-morbidity.
