1. Status report of Covid-19 patients at 08:00 AM (18th July)

A. Patient Census: Cumulative admissions of Covid-19 patients till date in AIIMS Bhopal – Five Hundred Forty Eight (548)

Total One Hundred Nineteen (119) Covid-19 patients are presently admitted in AIIMS, Bhopal.

There were Seventeen (17) new admissions of Covid-19 patients in AIIMS, Bhopal in last 24 hours.

One Hundred Eight (108) Covid-19 positive patients are receiving treatment at Covid-19 wards, AIIMS Bhopal. They are clinically stable.

Eleven (11) critically ill patients are admitted in Covid-19 ICU and are on oxygen support.

All admitted patients are receiving treatment as per Covid-19 treatment protocol.

B. Discharges Status: Till date a total of Three Hundred Twenty Eight (328) Covid-19 patients got recovered after successful treatment and care from AIIMS Bhopal.

Two (02) Covid19 patients were permitted for home isolation in accordance to protocol and guidelines.

No Covid-19 patient got discharged on 17th July from AIIMS Bhopal.

C. Death Status: Since beginning of Covid-19 crisis a total of Twenty Eight (28) deaths could be attributed to Covid-19 including One (01) brought dead in AIIMS Bhopal.

This includes one Sixty Two year old female Covid-19 patient from Bhopal city who has breathed her last in Covid19 ICU on 17th July. She was having Hypertension (BP) and Asthma as Co-morbidities and was admitted in AIIMS Bhopal since on 11th July .
